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LTC ACO Partners with SavaSeniorCare

[Kennett Square, PA] – February 12, 2020 – LTC ACO, the only post-acute care sponsored Accountable Care Organization (ACO) in the United States, today announced it has partnered with various operating entities affiliated with SavaSeniorCare Administrative Services, LLC (such operating entities, collectively, Sava), which on a consolidated basis is one of the largest providers of skilled nursing, memory care and rehabilitative services in the nation. The partnership will allow select physicians that provide care to long-term care residents in Sava facilities to participate in the Medicare Shared Savings Program (MSSP) through LTC ACO.

In 2016, LTC ACO began participating in the MSSP through GPS. GPS, the only captive SNFist company in the skilled nursing industry, has physicians, physician assistants and nurse practitioners who make more than half a million visits annually to both short- and long-stay patients, helping improve overall healthcare quality and reduce unnecessary hospital readmissions. With nearly four years of billing history and more than 6,000 long-term care residents, LTC ACO is the only post-acute provider in the country able to form an ACO via the MSSP.

Through the partnership, Sava will take advantage of LTC ACO's structure and breadth of experience to assist it in attempting to improve patient outcomes and reduce hospitalizations for its residents. In an environment where all providers are being asked to do more with less, the ACO structure allows Sava to share in the improvements it makes both from a quality and cost perspective. The ACO also allows Sava to better align the efforts of the physicians in its facilities, creating a collaborative environment to achieve these goals. Sava joins Senior Living Properties, another health care services provider of skilled nursing, long-term and rehabilitation, who joined LTC ACO last month.

“We, along with the rest of the industry, are always focused on improving quality and efficiency,” notes Jerry Roles, Chief Executive Officer of Sava. “With LTC ACO's help, we will

attempt to utilize their best practices and expertise to improve overall outcomes and quality while managing episodic and chronic cost.”

Under the partnership, LTC ACO passes along no risk to Sava and requires no capital outlay. LTC ACO will educate, train and report outcomes with the goal of driving improved patient outcomes, creating healthcare efficiencies and improving quality measures.
